### **RHEMA CSP & CDSP**

#### I. Child Survival Program

Our CSP project was started in 2005. In this month 2 mothers got begotten the male children by the grace of God. Now 1 pregnant mother and 36 children are there. Totally 37 Meetings to the Parents MCUs (Mother Child Unit) are getting benefits from our • On 14th of that month we organized the Thanks Giving CSP.

#### Activities:

- 27 Home visits done
- On 20th of this month we conducted the group curriculum meeting to the mothers. In that meeting we gave awareness about Kitchen Garden and Savings. Totally 16 mothers participated.

#### **Distribution:**

• Grains & Pulses were distributed to all the beneficiaries.

#### II. Child Development through sponsorship program

- The CDSP program was started in 2007 at Vellankuzhi village. Now 300 children are benefited in the CDSP program.
- 39 Home visits done
- We conducted the Child in prayer on 4th June 2016. Those children prayed for the requested prayer points based on the Prayer Book. In this Prayer meeting 83 CDSP Children and 22 Siblings attended. Totally 105 Children participated.
- On 18th of that month we conducted the Adolescent Training to the senior children. In that we gave awareness about the Limits and boundaries between the girls & boys relationship. 25 Girls and 17 Boys participated.
- Medical Camps
- Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are

no medical facilities; quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

- Prayer Meeting. 58 mothers participated.
- New Beneficiaries introduction meeting was conducted on 20th June 2016. We shared about the project details and Roles & responsibilities of the parents. Totally 13 parents participated.
- 22nd of the month we conducted the cluster wise parents meeting in 7 different areas. In that meeting we shared about the Importance of Education and Rights to Education Act. Totally 130 parents participated.

#### **Special Program**

**Home Prayer:** In that month we included 4 different areas. Totally we conducted the Home Prayer meetings in 20 beneficiaries' homes in different areas. The Home prayer conducted on different dates of the month. 19 CSP mothers, 102 CDSP mothers and 15 other mothers, totally 136 mothers participated. We shared the word of God based on the Bible verse Mark 1:15 "Jesus saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel." and also shared the word of God from the

• Luke 10: 38 to 42 under the topic "choose the good part in your life. Jesus is the Good partner in our Life".

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention  $% \mathcal{A}$ 

project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen

Men having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TNSACS for the next 1 year (April'16 to March'17).

#### Activities

- In the month of June 3 FSW were identified.
- ◆ Individual HRGs interactions with MSM was 619 and FSW was 660
- 20 Group meetings were conducted; 85 FSW's Participated.
- ♦ 13 Group meetings were conducted and 68 MSM's
- Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM 217

#### and FSW – 191

- Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW 86 and MSM 119
- Three DIC level meetings were conducted and MSM 32 , FSW -36 participated
- 11 Hotspot level meetings were conducted.

#### **Important Points:**

⇒ On 24.06.16 Mr. Shivakumar TANSACS – TSU – PO visited our NGO, for monthly visit. He gave some Observations and suggestions. He visited Melapalayam ICTC also. He also clarified about On-line report. He trained the M & E for using Tamil font in Master Register.

### **TI-MIGRANT PROJECT**

- ♦ 988 Migrants were identified as HRG.
- ◆ 1204 Migrants were provided with One to One (New).
- ◆ 247 Migrants were provided with One to One (Follow up).
- ◆ 130 Group Session were conducted and 1928 Migrants participated in the Group.
- ♦ 283 migrants tested in the ICTC camp.
- ♦ 418 migrants were given Counseling Service.
- ◆ 4 Vulnerable Migrants Visited the STI Clinic and 3 migrants were treated for STI in those migrants

during the Month.

- ◆ 4 Staff Review Meetings were conducted at Kavalkinaru office.
- ◆ 2 Games programs were conducted in Meenavankullam and Palauoor .
- ◆ 5 Health Camps were conducted in Palauoor (50)Kottaikarunkullam (50) Rathapuram (58) Kootapuli (120) Meenavankullam (75)353 migrants participated in the Health Camp.
- ◆ 2 Advocacy meetings held at Palauoor and Meenavankullam Area.

### CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 194 members, 127 members participated in the meeting.
- 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 31 members participated.
- Educational support is given to 7 CAA/CIA 7 students and R D amount is deposited in their Bank account.
- $\diamond~$  Six friends' forum programs were conducted and 36 members participated.

The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 57 children participated.

The Director Dr. R. Anburajan interacted with child Meghala and her mother regarding the health and the education.

### Educational Support to AAHIV/ALHIV children:-

Most of the Children's families who are living with AAHIV and ALHIV, feel difficult to run the family. They do not have

adequate income to provide school uniform and other school needs. That was brought to our notice and we have decided to provide the school needs of the children. Through this programme nearly 20 students got benefitted. Uniform, school bags and stationeries for the whole year is provided.
