RHEMA CSP &CDSP

I. Child Survival Program

Our CSP project was started in 2005. This month one mother has begotten a male child through the Normal delivery. Now 37 children and their mothers (totally 37 MCUs (Mother Child Unit)) are getting benefits from our CSP.

Activities:

• On 27th of this month we conducted the group curriculum meeting to the mothers under the topic "Addiction". 13 mothers were participated.

Distribution:

• Grains & Pulses were distributed to all the beneficiaries.

II. Child Development through sponsorship program

The CDSP program was started in 2007 at Vellankuzhi village. Now, 300 children are getting benefited through the CDSP program

- 15 Home visits were done
- 78.18% of the children participated in the Daily Activities
- Child in Prayer & Puppet show was conducted on 6th August 2016 and shared the word of God from Luke 11: 9 & 10 Jesus said you "seek, and ye shall find;" "he that seeketh findeth" Based on the verses we shared about the Zacchaeus story. After that the children prayed for the prayer points. 85 CDSP Children and 24 Siblings, Totally 109 Children were participated.
- Film show program was conducted on 13th of this month about "Faith & Obedience".

Meetings to the Parents

• Santhosa Club follow-up meeting was arranged on 24th August 2016, conducted by Pas. Joshua. 4 mothers participated.

Special Program

Home Prayer:

Home Prayer meetings was conducted in 19 beneficiaries' homes in different areas on 18th, 19th, 20th, 22nd, and 26th of this month. 18 CSP mothers, 107 CDSP mothers and 16 other mothers, totally 141 mothers were participated. We shared the word of God based on Luke 11:10 "For every one that asketh receiveth;" and also shared the passage from the Bible verses I Chronicles 4:9 & 10 under the topic Jabez call upon to God of Israel; And God granted him which he requested.

Independence Day Celebration:

70th Independence Day was celebrated on 15th August 2016. Mas. Surya and team performed March-Fast. Our national flag was hoisted by the chief guest Mr. Jebamani Mathiyas, Head Master, St. John's Primary School, Vellankuli and he delivered the special speech. Our CSP mother led the participants to take Oath. Our CDSP children performed a dance and also delivered a speech about the "VOC &Mahadma Gandhiji".

Day of the Fasting Prayer & Special Prayer:

Day of the Fasting prayer and the Special Prayer was conducted by Pastor. Savarimuthu and Bro. Vijay, Project Coordinator on 31st August 2016, 62 parents participated in the fasting prayer and 134 students participated in the special prayer. All the staff were present in both the prayers.

NSS Camp

We arranged the 2 days NSS camp along with the NSS team from Govt. ITI, Ambasamudram. Mr. Murugesan, NSS in-charge and Sir. Solomon organized the NSS team on 23rd & 24th August 2016. In the 2 days camp 30 students involved in cleaning the village and especially leveling the play ground for our children. And they extended their service in 3 schools and the community peoples by cleaning. Electrical and Plumbing works were also done based on the needs. Mr. Gangadharan, vicepresident of Vellankuli Panchayath, encouraged the students by his motivational talk.



TANSACS Core Group Project

AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TNSACS for the next 1 year. (April'16 to March'17) Activities

Followings are the activities implemented in the month of Aug'16

- In the month Aug'16 3 FSW, 2 MSM and 2 TGs were identified.
- ♦ Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 618 and FSW was 663.
- ♦ 6 Group meetings were conducted; 45 FSW's participated.
- Group meetings were conducted and 74 MSM's were participated.
- Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM 189 and FSW - 171

- The APAC VHS USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ ◆ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW 101 and MSM -94
 - ♦ Three DIC level meetings were conducted

Important Points:

- ⇒ On 11.08.16, Project Manager and M & E participated in the Regional Review Meeting at Thiruchendure SED-CO NGO.
- ⇒ On 13.08.16, a small meeting was conducted by TANSACS - TI - TSU - PO Mr. Shivakumar for the purpose of updating online report in good quality.
- ⇒ On 16.08.16, Aadi Thabasu, the staff displayed the awareness in Exhibition stall with the support of DPM and Sankarankoil ICTC Counsellors.

PEACE TRUST TANSACS-TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

- 785 Migrants were identified as HRG.
- 943Migrants were provided with One to One (New).
- 233Migrants were provided with One to One (Follow up).
- 115 Group Session were conducted and 1622 Migrants participated in the Group.
- 314 migrants were tested in the ICTC camp.
- 392migrants were given Counseling Service.
- 6 Vulnerable Migrants visited the STI Clinic and 5 migrants were treated for STI in those migrants during the Month.

- 4 Staff Review Meetings were conducted at Kavalkinaru
- 2 Games programs were conducted in Panakudi and Pulavankudiruppu.
- 5 Health Camps were conducted in Devarkulam(130), Panakudi(50), Koodankulam(75), Pulavankudiruppu(65), Koodankulam(50), 370 migrants participated in the Health Camp.
- 2 Advocacy meetings were held at Devarkulam and Koodankulam Area.
