RHEMA CSP &CDSP

I. Child Survival Program

Our CSP project was started in 2005. 37 children and their mothers (totally 37 MCUs (Mother Child Unit)) are getting benefits from our CSP.

Activities:

- CSP mothers group meeting conducted on 17th September 2016, in that we taught about "Help to Others" through the games. The mothers involved very well, totally 20 mothers participated.
- On 24th of this month we conducted the group curriculum meeting to the mothers. In that meeting we gave awareness about "How to control the emotional feelings" through the group discussion. Totally 24 mothers were participated.

Distribution:

 Vegetables, Fruits, Grains & Pulses were distributed to the beneficiaries.

II. Child Development through

sponsorship program

The CDSP program was started in 2007 at Vellankuzhi village. Now there are 300 children getting benefits in the CDSP program.

- * 85 Homes were visited.
- * 74.73% of the children participated in the Daily Activities
- * We conducted the Child in Prayer on 3rd September 2016. Children participation

was very well in that prayer meeting. They jointly prayed for the prayer points requested. 83 children attended in the prayer meeting.

- * We arranged the Adolescent Health Training on 5th September 2016. In this training the resource persons separated the boys and girls, and taught about the protection of mental and physical health in this adult's stage. And also clearly clarified the children doubts through personal & group counseling. 48 senior children attended in the Training Program.
- * On 13th September 2016, Jesus Redeems Children Ministries organized the Kids camp at Sarah Tucker School Auditorium, Palayamkottai. In that camp our children participated and enjoyed in the common session and class sesson also. They learnt many action songs and enjoyed in the puppet show and drama. 74 children participated and committed to "walk with Jesus".

Santhosa Club Home Visits

On 21st and 22nd of this month we visited the 8 Santhosa club member's houses along with Santhosa club Organizer Pas. Joshua. He encouraged the people to come forward the sober life and continue participation in the Santhosa club activities.

Special Program

Home Prayer:

In the month we conducted the

Home Prayer meetings in the 20 beneficiaries' homes in different areas. 15 CSP mothers, 108 CDSP mothers and 14 other mothers, totally 137 mothers were participated in the Home prayers. We shared the word of God based on the Bible verse Psalm 126:5 and shared the bible character about "Annal" from the scripture portion of I.SAMUEL 1:1-18.

Gospel & Prayer Meeting:

We arranged the Gospel & Prayer Meeting on 21st September 2016. Prayer was conducted by Pastor. Yesudasan and the word of God shared from the Bible verses "Isaiah 54: 10 & 11"17 CSP mothers and 59 CDSP mothers participated in the meeting.

LINKS PEACE-MED

SHARON CHILDREN HOME

EDUCATION-

During this month of September 2016, quarterly examinations for the children were held from 14.09.2016 to 23.09.2016. For this quarterly examination, the children were taught with special care and attention to score high marks. The children had nice holidays from 24.09.2016 to 2nd October 2016. The boys had returned to our Sharon Children home after enjoying the holidays on 2.10.2016 evening. Now the total strength of the Home is 26. We are trying to admit four boys from nearby villages.

The following boys were very weak in studies and scored only 30% of marks in the month of August 2016.

Birthday Celebration:-

Birthday was celebrated for Master.Mariaraj



and Jesu by cutting cake. All the children were participated in this programme and wished them by singing birth day song and finally cake was dis-

tributed to all the children.

MEDICAL REPORT-

- I. Master Vijay studying 8th STD is having eye problem. He was taken to Aravind Eye Hospital, Tirunelveli for treatment. The Doctor advised him to wear spectacles for now and asked to come for review after two month
- 2. Master Suresh studying 7th STD had Mums, which infected from the school. After the holidays, he is now okay.

Sports:- All boys below 8th STD studying in TDTA Middle school Perumalkulam .There was a sports competition conducted by the school for three days. In these competition 10 boys from our home participated. And participated children received medals in various sports activities, Running Race, Chocó, Kabadi, etc. The photos are attached.

Visitors:- Mrs. Kathika Counselor and one staff from District Child Protection Office inspected our Home on 26.09.2016. They verified all records in our home and instructed to use the room in 1st floor which is not utilized now. They also appreciated all our activities and records maintaining. They are also very much impressed for the neat and cleanliness of our home. The counselor insisted to conduct the management committee meeting

soon.

Administration:- As per the Government direction CCTV camera is fitted on 18.09.2016 in our home and this was also inspected by the DCPO office counselor and staff. In addition to this two led lights were fixed which can be connected to the inverter when there is no power supply.

Staff Meeting:

Sharon Home Staff Review Meeting was conducted on 2.10.2016 at 4.30 pm by the Project Manager in the Sharon Home itself. In the meeting all the staff were advised to take necessary steps to improve the children in their studies from the 2nd Term onwards. Mr. Chandran, English teacher shared his experience with the boys. He was instructed to pay more concentration on 10th and 12th students who are going to attend the Government examination and Mr. Basker Durai, tuition teacher is advised to pay special attention in all other subjects.

and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to
the TNSACS for the next I year. (April'16 to March'17) Activities

- * Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 594 and FSW was 666.
- * 10 Groups meetings were conducted; 44 FSW's participated.
- 8 Groups meetings were conducted and 55 MSM's were participated.
- * Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics 380

- (7 Presumptive test & 373 RMC)
- * Number of ICTC Referral and tested for 206
- * Three DIC level meetings were conducted

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 198 members, 144 members participated in the meeting.
- 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 32 members participated.
- Educational support is given to 3 CAA/CIA 3 students and RD amount is deposited in their Bank account.
- Six friends' forum programs were conducted and 39 members participated.

The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 67 children participated.

- ⇒ New Adolescent club 10 formed.
- ⇒ Totally 218 members were enrolled in the club

LSE Training Programme:

A LSE training programme was organized and conducted through Provision on 27.9.2016. This programme was especially for New Adolescent club volunteers and the existing staff. A new 10 modules were prepared for this year. It was new one to the present volunteers. So the pro- vision thought to train the new volunteers. In our project 5 volunteers and one staff participated in this training.

In this training Resource Person Mr. Johnselvin, Trustee of Pro-vision

handle the session. Training was very useful to participants the LSE secession with new modules. Also he shared the methodology to be adopted when the volunteers handle the LSE session. And now the volunteers conduct the group discussions.

HIV /AIDS awareness Meeting:

This meeting conducted at Manonmaiam University through the Education Department. Prof. William Thanaraj HOD



welcomes the participants and resource person. Mrs. Mari Peace Trust called upon to handle the meeting to give the knowledge about the HIV/AIDS to the participants. In this meeting the statistical of HIV/AIDS shared to the students. Most of the students not having the knowledge. Our staff explained the issues faced by the

Adolescents in detail. More over explain the activities which are undergone in Peace Trust through Malteser international Germany.
