Child in Prayer

We organized the Child in Prayer for our children on 4th of this month. The children were separated in five groups and prayed for the requested prayer points. In this meeting 27 boys, 49 girls and 27 siblings, totally 100 children participated.

CSP Curriculum Meeting

We conducted the 3 CSP curriculum meetings on the following dates of this month in that we shared about the following topics to the mothers through the various methods.

4th Feb 2017 – How to develop the children in their Cognitive developmental area – 17 mothers participated

18th Feb 2017 – Physical developmental area of the small & big movements – 17 mothers participated

25th Feb 2017 – Puppet show about the Faith & Respected others – 19 mothers participated

Students Special Meeting

We conducted the Students Special Meeting about How to face the Public Exam for the 9th to 12th Standard children. We projected the video clips of Dr. R. Anburajan shared the topic is "Victory in Exams". Then we gave the study schedule and health tips follows during the time of Exam. 46 Children participated in this meeting.

Home Prayer

On 10th to 28th February 2017, we conducted the 20 Home Prayers in Different areas. In this home prayer the topic was Fasting Prayer based on the Bible verse from Joel 2:15 and shared about the Jonah said that prophesy about Nineveh City shall be overthrown. They turned from their evil way and God repented. We prayed for the requested prayer points by the mothers who participated. Totally 10 CSP mothers, 96 CDSP mothers and 13 others participated.

Competitive Exam Coaching Class

We conducted the Competitive Exam coaching class on 26th Feb 2017 onwards.

LINKS PEACE-MED

Programme is functioning well with 155 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 36 beneficiaries encouraging with MED loan.

SHARON CHILDREN HOME

Education:

Five boys from our Home are appearing for the Government examinations during the month of March 2017. Personal advice was given to them by the Project Manager, Bro. David Johnson to study well for these examinations and try to obtain more marks and instructed the tutor to pay more attention to these students.

Administration:

The Assistant Director Mr. C. Devaraj, Peace Trust visited the home periodically. He has taken special steps for getting renewal for the Registration Certificate by contacting the concerned Government departments to get

NOC and other certificates.

Home Management committee meeting:

The home management committee meeting was conducted on 24.2.2017 at our Children Home. The following resolutions were passed in the meeting.

- A special care shall be provided to 10th & 12th students for Government examination.
- A part-time counselor shall be appointed for counseling the children.
- All children should be vaccinated with MR vaccine (Rubella)
- All the children should be enrolled in Aadhaar and bank account.

Priyam Girls Program:-

This program was conducted on 11.02.2017 at 4.00 pm at CSI Church, premises Kalakadu. In this program all the eight girls participated and received the tuition fees and Nutrition for the month of February 2017.

Nesam Higher studies Program: M. Sofia-

On 17th February 2017 Project Manager had visited the TDMNS College Kalikulam where Ms. Sofia doing her B.A. (History) and met Mrs. Balasaraswathy Department in-charge. She shared that Sofia is a hard working and brilliant student.

TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'16 to March'17).

Followings are the activities implemented in the month of February '17

- ♦ Individual HRGs interactions with MSM was 664 and FSW was 679.
- ♦ 12 Group meetings were conducted; 63 FSW's participated.
- ♦ 10 Group meetings were conducted and 50 MSM's participated.
- ♦ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM -

195 and FSW – 221 (Total : 416)

- ♦ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 110 and MSM – 99 (Total : 209)
- ♦ Three DIC level meetings were conducted and 92 HRG's participated
- ♦ 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (78 HRG's conducted)
- ♦ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 682 and MSM : 673 (Total : 1355)

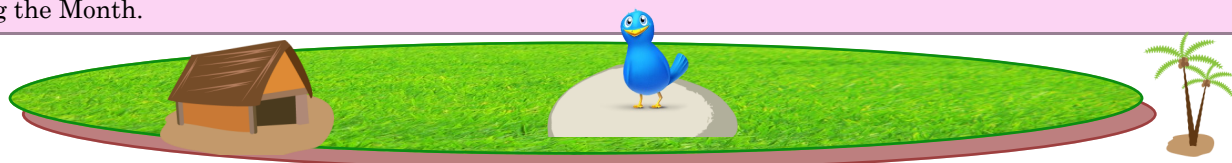
Important Points:

- ⇒ On 01.2.17 Mr. Shivakumar TANSACS – TSU – PO visited our NGO for monthly visit. He gave some valuable Observations and suggestions.
- ⇒ We celebrated Community Event on 23.02.17. 167 HRGs were attended the event.

TANSACS TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

- ⇒ 665 Migrants were identified as HRG.
- ⇒ 774 Migrants were provided with One to One (New).
- ⇒ 204 Migrants were provided with One to One (Follow up).
- ⇒ 114 Group Sessions were conducted and 1635 Migrants participated.
- ⇒ 119 migrants tested in the ICTC camp.
- ⇒ 324 migrants were given Counseling Service.
- ⇒ 2 Vulnerable Migrants Visited the STI Clinic and 2 migrants were treated for STI in those migrants during the Month.

- ⇒ 4 Staff Review Meetings were conducted at Kavalkinaru office.
- ⇒ 2 Games programs were conducted in Panagudi and Pulavankudiruppu.
- ⇒ 6 Health Camps were conducted in Koodankulam (60) Tirunelveli (54) Anna Nagar (52) Panagudi (60) Veerankulam (53) Pulavankudiruppu (60) 339 migrants participated in the Health Camp.
- ⇒ 2 Advocacy meetings held at Veerankulam and Panagudi Area.



CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

⇒ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 200, 144 members participated in the meeting.

⇒ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39, 33 members participated.

⇒ Seven friends' forum programs were conducted and 45 members participated.

The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 77 children participated.

◇ **New Adolescent clubs 13 were formed.**

◇ **Totally 340 members were enrolled in the club**

Carrer Guidance training programme

Career guidance Training programme were conducted in Sankarankoil Block and Palayamkottai block on 19.2.2017 and 26.2.2017. In which Kuruvikulam, Vausudevanallur and Sankarankoil block club members, Palayamkottai and corporation AAHIV/ALHIV are the training participants. 67 adolescents were participated from 3 blocks. The training resource person Mr. Balamurugan came from Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. He handled the training and insisted 10th & 12th students and

orientation was given to join the course, what is very useful for job oriented in future with the available marks in the 10th & 12th examination

Volunteer Life Skill Training.

This training was conducted on 27.2.2017 at Peace Transformation centre. In our Peace Trust the 5 volunteers participated. Mr. John Selvin resource person came from Salvation Army Nagercoil, who handled the secession and how to take the LSE secession with Adolescents. He also gave a fruitful idea for handling the adolescents in the training. And also the four partners field Counselors took the secession to the volunteer.
